What's included:

1. Smoke alarm check

- Check, clean and expiration date examination.
- Replacement when necessary

2. GFCI outlet check

- Check, and replace when necessary

3. Lighting

- Replace those hard to reach light bulbs (see notes)

4. Electrical panel checkup

The electrical panel is the heart of the safety system.

It must be in tip-top shape at all times.

- Visual inspection of circuit breakers (checking that circuit breakers are correct and not overheating)
- Check that all electrical connections in panel are tight
- Clean away any build-up of debris in panel

5. Service check

- Checking the electrical service and Emily knob

6. Ask an electrical expert

- Lighting advice on LEDs (where, when & what type)
- Electric vehicle charging
- General advice, answering any other electrical questions that you may have.
